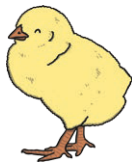
Cut out shapes to make an Easter chick or rabbit

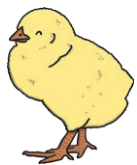
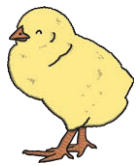
Draw out a hopscotch grid with chalk – you could add numbers, letters or challenges in each square. google 'hopscotch ideas' for more

Hide your Easter eggs in the garden. How many can you find? Who has the most? Who has the least amount of eggs?

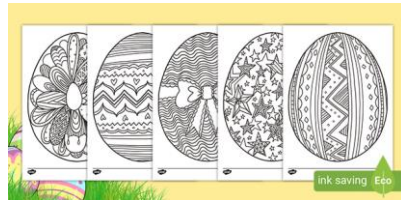
