### Maths

Log onto [MyMaths](#) = username: hoddern password: ilovemaths2

Then enter your own individual username and password to take you to your portal.

You will see you've been set 3 homework activities to complete. These are all to do with work you've covered in Year 3.

Remember to click on Lesson first to go over the activities first.

You're aiming for 90% so have 2-3 or more tries! Every time it will bring up new questions.

You can also have a go at the games to practise lots of your other maths skills - telling the time, estimating, adding etc. As well as doing any 'overdue' homework from earlier in the year that you haven't done.

Don't forget to log out properly, this will save your work.

### English - Writing
