<p>9.00-9.30</p>	<p align="center">Shared Reading and Phonic Activities</p> <p>Sing Jolly Phonic Sounds song Phase 2 and 3 Read pages from your phonic booklets. Model blending the words, children to say the words clearly. Try Pick A Picture on Phonics Play Phase 2 to Phase 4 https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/#</p> 
<p>9.30-9.45</p>	 <p>Watch the captions; https://www.ictgames.com/mobilePage/literacy.html Choose phase 3 digraphs that your child is not confident recording. Watch the clips several times. Write the captions. Emphasise leaving a finger space between words and underline the digraph so children see it as a unit of sound.</p>

Predict then observe what happens. What will dissolve? Test out different substances eg sugar, oil, salt, colouring. Predict what will happen when they are added to warm water. Model how to answer in a full sentence.</p>
