We follow White Rose Maths in school.

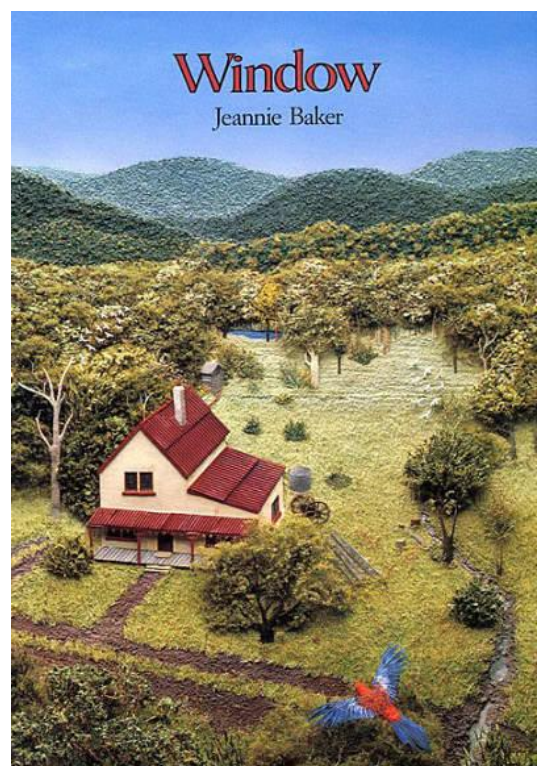

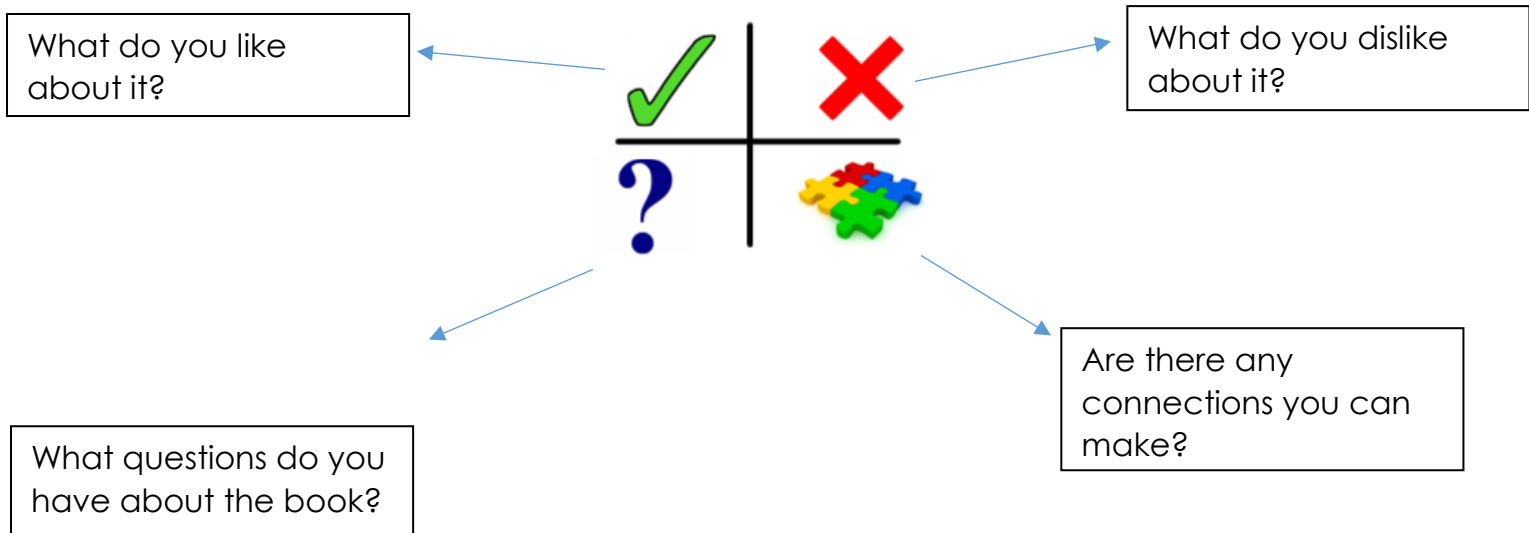
