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### **10.45 – 11:30 Written task**

Today you are going to write the **first TWO paragraphs** of your story!

Get out your plan from yesterday to help you with ideas.

In this **first paragraph** you need to **introduce your main character**.

What's his name? How old is he? What does he look like? Is he quiet? Or excitable? What does he do during the day?

In the **second paragraph** you are going to **describe where he lives**.

What is his house like? Who does he live with? What is the town like? Is it too small to be a town? Is it a village instead? Is it too small to be a village? Is it a hamlet (a tiny village) instead? What is the name of the town/village/hamlet? Is it full of traffic and noise? Is the sky dark grey because of all the car pollution?

**Draw or paint a picture similar to the first page in our book, Window.**

You need to **create cut-outs** of houses or buildings and **stick them on your original picture/painting** so your landscape changes too.
