How old are you now? What else has been built? Has it changed anything else? What has it changed? Is it a good change, a bad change or both? Why is the main character playing inside now?

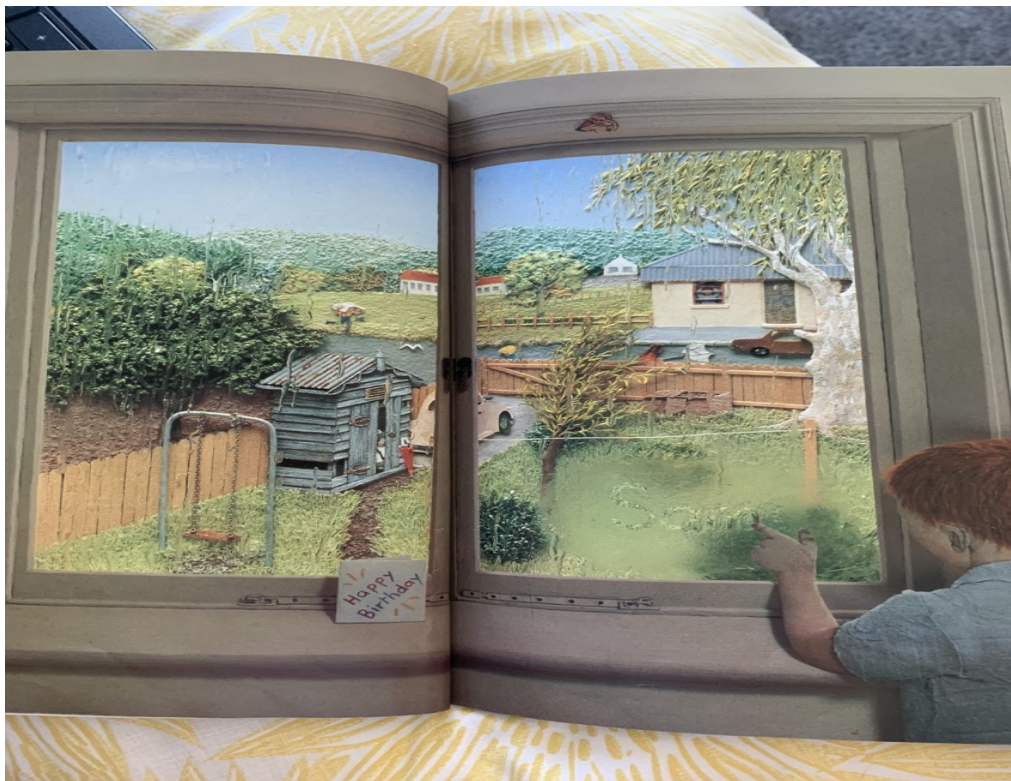
Here are some sentence starters to help you:
